


WHAT IS A STROKE?

- A stroke occurs when the blood supply to the brain gets cut off
- The blood supply to the brain can get cut off in two ways:

A clot blocks an artery, called an ischemic stroke

An ischemic stroke is a clogged pipe



An artery bursts and bleeds, called a hemorrhagic stroke




Another illustration of ischemic and hemorrhagic strokes



Ischemic Stroke







Weakened vessel wall ruptures causing bleeding in the brain

WHAT IS A TIA?

- A TIA, or Transient Ischemic Attack, is a stroke that comes and goes quickly
- A TIA happens when there is a brief stop in blood supply to the brain
- TIAs can be warning signs for future strokes!
